Vote regarding Assisted Suicide Bill - why should I write to my M.P? - Please write to your M.P. urging them to vote 'No' on **29th November** to the Assisted Suicide Bill, which seeks to allow people, under certain circumstances to be put to death by medical professionals.

Evidence from Oregon, in the U.S, whose laws have been quoted as a model for the U.K show that 47% of those choosing assisted suicide did so to due to concerns that they were a 'burden on family and friends'. Hospice UK has identified over 100,00 people die every year without access to palliative care, which caused the government to state the NHS is 'going through the biggest crisis in its history'. Against this backdrop, now is not the time to legalise assisted suicide. Not one organisation of disabled people has called for the Bill or supports it.
